

## ✓ THE UJA-FEDERATION ROSE BILLER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

We are pleased to announce the tenth year of the UJA-Federation Biller Fund Scholarship Program. This program provides approximately \$1 Million in scholarships to Jewish men and women with significant financial need in the New York Metropolitan Area. The program is administered by the Hebrew Free Loan Society in accordance with the attached guidelines. Both men and women can apply for scholarships of up to \$5,000.

### THE UJA-FEDERATION ROSE BILLER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES

1. The UJA-Federation Rose Biller Scholarship Program provides scholarships to Jewish men and women with significant economic need attending undergraduate, graduate, and professional schools.
2. Biller applicants must be legal **permanent** residents of the United States. International students visiting the United States with F, B, M, J, or other visas are not eligible for this award.
3. Biller applicants must be Jewish residents of either New York City or the counties of Nassau, Suffolk and Westchester (the “New York Metropolitan Area”). Please note that returning students not originally residents of the New York Metropolitan Area who have registered to vote in the New York Metropolitan Area are deemed to be New York Metropolitan Area residents for purposes of applying for this scholarship.
4. Applicants must be students at colleges or graduate or professional schools located in the New York Metropolitan Area and must be physically in attendance at New York Metropolitan Area campuses. Students who are studying abroad or at satellite campuses or who are completing internships outside of the New York Metropolitan Area are not eligible to apply.
5. Each student selected for a Biller/ JFEW Scholarship will receive up to a maximum of \$5,000. **Students must re-apply each year.**
6. Biller Scholarships will not be awarded to medical, dental or law students (with the exception of CUNY law students). Émigrés women from the former Soviet Union, studying medicine and dentistry may be eligible to apply for the JFEW Émigrés in Health Sciences Scholarship.
7. All scholarship decisions are final.
